Biography

Captain Dieter Harms, born in 1940, started his career over 48 years ago with Lufthansa German Airlines.

He flew a wide variety of aircraft and retired by late 2005 as a Captain on B 747- 400.

He was the Head of the Lufthansa Pilot School in Bremen and Phoenix, AZ from 1980 until 1990, thereafter the Head of Training of Lufthansa German Airlines and from 1997 until his retirement the CEO of the newly founded Lufthansa Flight Training (FTO and TRTO), a Lufthansa daughter company. Captain Harms was involved with the application of Competency Based Training and the development of the Multi-Crew Pilot Licence (MPL) right from the beginning and served as an advisor to the ICAO FCLT-Panel from 2000 to 2005 and to the CJAA during the transposition of the MPL from Annex 1 into JAR-FCL in 2006.

Besides running his consulting firm he works for IATA since 2007 as a Senior Advisor in the IATA Training and Qualification Initiative (ITQI) and as a consultant for international training providers and airlines on the implementation of MPL.

Capt. Harms served as a member of the EASA MPL Advisory Board from the beginning in 2009 until its disbandment in 2017.
